

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – The first Canadian *Supercar*, the Plethore LC-750, finally presented in Canada.

**MONTREAL, February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2010.** Recently arrived from Scottsdale, Arizona, where the well-known Barrett-Jackson Autoshow took place from January 17<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>, HTT Technologies now announces its presence at the *Canadian International AutoShow* in Toronto from February 12th to 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010 (www.autoshow.ca).

The first Canadian *Supercar*, the Plethore LC-750, literally stole the show at the Barrett-Jackson Autoshow.
